

Weaned bulls are trailed 25 miles to the Storer Ranch where they are wintered

SALE BULLS

All bulls are spring born and weaned in early fall. They are kept on meadows until we trail them 25 miles by horseback to the Storer Ranch, where they are wintered. There the bulls are kept in large sandy lots and fed a high roughage, growing ration. They are performance tested as one group, subject to identical environmental conditions.

PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

- **ADJUSTED 205 DAY WEIGHT:** Actual weaning weights adjusted to 205 days of age.
- **YEARLING WEIGHT:** Bull adjusted to a 365 day weight.
These weights are for in herd comparison only.
- **A.D.G.:** Measurement of average daily body weight gain of bull on test.
- **W.D.A.:** Weight of bull divided by days of age as of February 16, 2009.

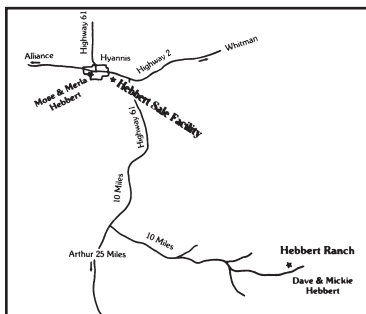

If a replacement bull is not available, credit will be issued at the next annual sale. All claims for replacements need to be made by September 1st of the current year.
